The Designer

You might call Wendy Konradi's style one of high contrasts and graphic details: precisely cut platinum hair, necklace from the K/LLER Collection in porcupine quills and bronze, all framed by a palette of black or white. Konradi, an interior designer who trained with Naomi Leff in New York and has been working with Emily Summers Design Associates here since 2000, favors both the delicate and strong.
